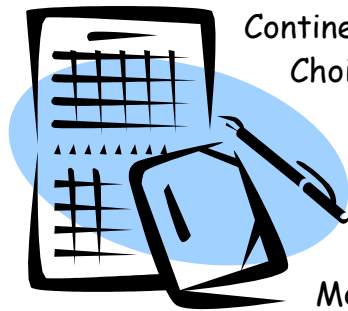

Jack has preached (some of them right here at West End).

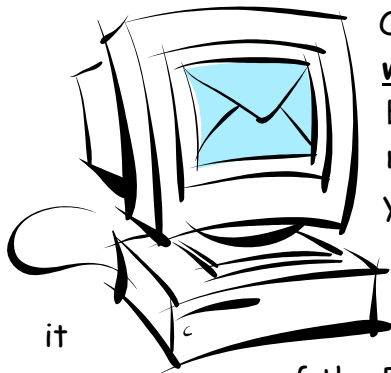
