WHAT DOES A BELIEVER LOOK LIKE?

"Who shall ascend unto the Hill of the Lord? Or who shall stand in His Holy Place? He that has clean hands, and a pure heart; who has not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully. He shall receive the blessing from The

Lord and righteousness from The God of his salvation"
(Psalms 24:3-5)

If you are going to heaven; it makes a BIG difference how you live on earth! As a matter of fact, your life is the only thing that others can see that God's Grace has worked its good work in you. I wish that all who claim to be Christian could read this.

There are so very many who believe - as I certainly do - in the "eternal security of the Saints"; but who go so far with that thinking - as I certainly do not - that they put down all "good works" as being unnecessary! That's just wrong on so many levels!

Yes, it's true that good works are not essential to YOUR being saved - or YOUR staying saved - but they certainly are essential to SOMEONE ELSE being saved. In fact, probably the greatest hindrance to sinners being saved is the fact that church members don't conduct themselves as Christians should! And, you know, it's funny; no one really has to ask how Christians should conduct themselves. We really do basically know what's right and wrong.

So, let us covenant together that we will be able to lift up spiritually clean and holy hands unto The Lord.

That's all well and good! But, as wonderful as it is; clean hands alone will not suffice. No! They must be connected to a pure spirit. True religion is "spiritual-work". You can scrub the outside of the cup until all the glaze comes off the ceramic; but if the inside is dirty, it still makes everything that goes into it unclean.

Spiritually, if the outside is clean; but the inside is dirty; we are filthy through and through. In fact, a person might be the "cleanest" sinner in Cocke County - but that will not get that person one inch into heaven at the moment of death.

Actually, our spiritual selves are more truly "us" than anything else about us. The true spiritual life of our very innermost being lies in our inner natures; and that's why it is imperative that the inner self be morally pure and spiritually clean.

It is "the pure in heart" that shall "see God"; all the rest are as blind as a bat.

The man bound for heaven "has not lifted up his soul unto vanity".

Now, everyone has their "fun"; their light-hearted moments; and I see nothing wrong with having fun at times; but the unsaved world has its "fun" and "pleasures" deeply rooted in carnal, worldly, and impure things - empty vanities which are going nowhere but downhill; really helping no one to become a Christian.

Spurgeon said, "He who is content with the husks shall be reckoned with the swine". May I ask you: does the world and its pleasures satisfy you? If they do; then you better make the most of it, because - as the commercial says - "It doesn't get any better than this". It's true; the world is as good as you will ever experience.

The Believer does not "swear deceitfully". The Saints of God have an honor that is high and above anything the world has to offer. The Bible says, "Those

things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart, and they defile the man" (Matthew 15:18)

The Believer is a "Holy" person. Jesus said, "Sanctify them though Thy Word; Thy Word is Truth" (John 17:17).

A lot of Baptists do not want to discuss "Sanctification" and "Holiness"; because they don't know what they mean.

Being "sanctified" simply means "being a holy one". It begins at the moment a person is born again - and yes, a person can be born again without being baptized, or joining a church, or giving a dime - but these things should come right along in the progression as you get closer and closer to Christ; you want to get closer and closer to His Life Style.

In a nutshell; a person going to heaven has his sins forgiven in the **PAST!**

He also has a wonderful **PRESENT!** It's FUN being saved; knowing your sins are forgiven and the BIG problem of unbelief has been solved! So, if you are Child of The King - ACT LIKE IT!

But - and here is the best part - the **FUTURE** is plumb out of this world!

The person going to heaven can already begin to see the gates of pearl, walls of jasper, street of gold; light that never needs a lamp; river that never needs a filter - all the delights of heaven. He can hear the gorgeous music of the angel choir; and Bible studies led by The Author Himself!

And he can look forward to the Second Coming of Jesus Christ too!

In the meantime, we want to "walk worthy of the vocation wherewith we have been called".
