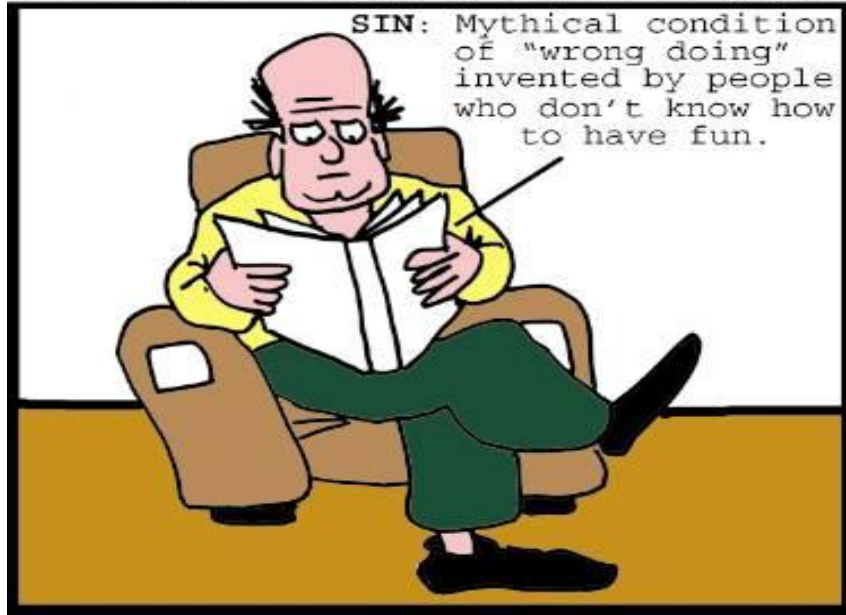

and her staff work with the older group. They leave the main auditorium right after "Shake 'n Howdy Time" in the Morning Service (about 11:20).

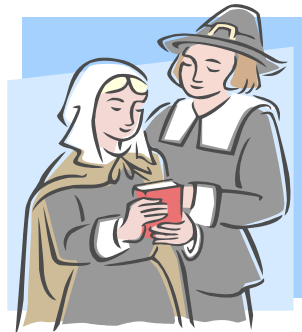
They leave the auditorium at 6:20 in the Evening Service; and go straight to their classes at 7:00 on Wednesday Evening.
