**THE CENTER PIECE**

**"Preterism"**

The "Preterist" (Latin for "past") believes that most, if not all, of prophecy was fulfilled by the time of the destruction of Jerusalem in 70 AD. They quote Matthew 24:34: "... This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled"; and interpret

that as saying that the prophecies had to be fulfilled in the first century.

Most "preterists" are therefore forced to believe that for this to be true, we are presently living in a "new heaven and a new earth".

This leads them to have to believe that "The Second Coming of Christ" occurred in 70 AD; and there is no future "Return of Jesus Christ". In turn, this belief system forces them to believe that John wrote The Book of Revelation before that date.

If we are living in the "new heavens and the new earth"; certain things have to fall in place:

(1) - There would be no Satan (Rev 20:10).

(2) - There would be no death, crying, or pain (Rev 21:4).

(3) - There would be no unclean persons practicing abominations and lying (Rev 21:27).

(4) - There would be no curse of God on the earth (Rev 22:3).

Oddly, Preterists believe that Believers suffered only until 70 AD because we are now in a time of peace!

More oddly, if Preterists are correct; most of the events predicted in Biblical prophecies are historically over; and the current church is getting increasingly more and more successful, concluding with the world being converted to Christ! They believe that the "great apostasy" occurred in the first century.

Because there are preachers and teachers all across the world that are spreading this false doctrine; we need to know what we believe and be ready to defend it.

You would think these people would be laughed out of town for teaching such heresy; but they never come in a "frontal attack" on dispensationalism or pre-tribulationism; they use stealth and covert acts to sneak up on the unsuspecting unsaved and the ill-informed church members. They never identify themselves for what they really are and what they really believe; and generally never get involved with such Passages of Scripture in their services, which are mostly consumed with "making life better", "saving Mother Earth" or "the whales, trees, or snail darters".

The unfortunate souls who attend these churches every week never hear a message or receive a challenge to accept Jesus Christ as personal Savior; and they will die in their sins and go to hell, all the while thinking they are "right with God".

They can certainly not obey our Lord's clear command to keep watching until He comes: Matthew 24:42 - "Watch therefore: for you know not what hour your Lord doth come".

## **ABOUT THE COVER**



This picture was shared with us by Omega Jackson about two years before she died. It shows the original structure of this church before all the many renovations it has undergone. The early worshippers en-

tered directly into the one room which we now call "The Chapel". Two class rooms, two extremely small rest rooms, and a new entrance were added soon thereafter; followed by a baptistery and classroom annex.

That "Old Auditorium" was remodeled in 1960, 1971, 1975, and 1991. The "Memorial Annex" was added in 1973; the "Main Auditorium", classrooms, and nursery complex project (shown below) was constructed in 1984; and the Family Life Center and youth complex was added in 2001.
